The purpose of this document is to assist the EOR in the preparation of the Intent and Scope within the Spec Package.

The highlighted portion is completed through Specs on the Web, or by editing the merged specification package (all information should be consistent with the applicable information found on the Plans, Transmittal Memo, and PSEE Project Information):

## Article 4-1 Intent and Scope

The County must be listed in the Intent and Scope.

When listing Items of Work, be sure to include all work mix groups that are included in the project; the information is used in the advertisement. Contractors and subcontractors use this information to determine if the advertisement includes a work mix of interest to them. As a rule of thumb, include all work mix groups that are either 5% or more of the Contract amount, or are a component within the plan set. A list of common work mix items used:

- New Bridge Construction
- Bridge-Replace and Add Lanes
- Bridge-Rehabilitate and Add Lanes
- MSE Walls
- Add Lanes & Reconstruct
- Add Lanes & Rehabilitate Pavement
- Interchange Ramp (New)

- Milling & Resurfacing
- Base Work
- **Shoulder Treatment**
- Landscaping
- **Drainage Improvements**
