Scope of Work

The Scope of Work proposes the physical work that needs to be accomplished within the project. This work gives specific instructions detailing the project's physical location and what has been identified as a requirement or purpose of the project. The Scope of Work is the individual project and what will need to be added and done throughout the project. This may include:

- Installations
- New Transportation Facilities (roadways, bridges, sidewalks, shared-use paths...)
- Milling and Resurfacing
- Rehabilitation
- Safety Projects
- Landscaping

The Scope of Work is created within the Planning phase and will be updated throughout each phase.

The Scope of Work is often mistaken for the Scope of Services. More information can be found regarding the Scope of Services in <u>PMG 225</u> or the Scope of Services Webpage. If the Scope of Work is changed after Notice to Proceed, the Scope of Services will require updates which will need to be processed through a Supplemental Agreement (SA). An SA will contain the additional work required for the project or the removal of work originally within the Scope of Work.
