INDEX

35.1 OVERVIEW

An index is included in all Environmental Impact Statements (EISs) ([Part 2, Chapter 1, Document Format and Table of Contents](#)). The purpose of the Index is to provide a detailed listing of major subject areas (especially areas of significant impact) so that a reviewer does not have to read the entire EIS to obtain information on a specific subject.

35.2 PROCEDURE

35.2.1 Content of Index

The Index is provided for the convenience of the reader. It is an alphabetical listing of major subjects covered in the EIS. Areas of community concern and areas which have a significant impact on the surrounding environment should also be listed in the Index.

Provided below is an illustration of the typical content of an index.
