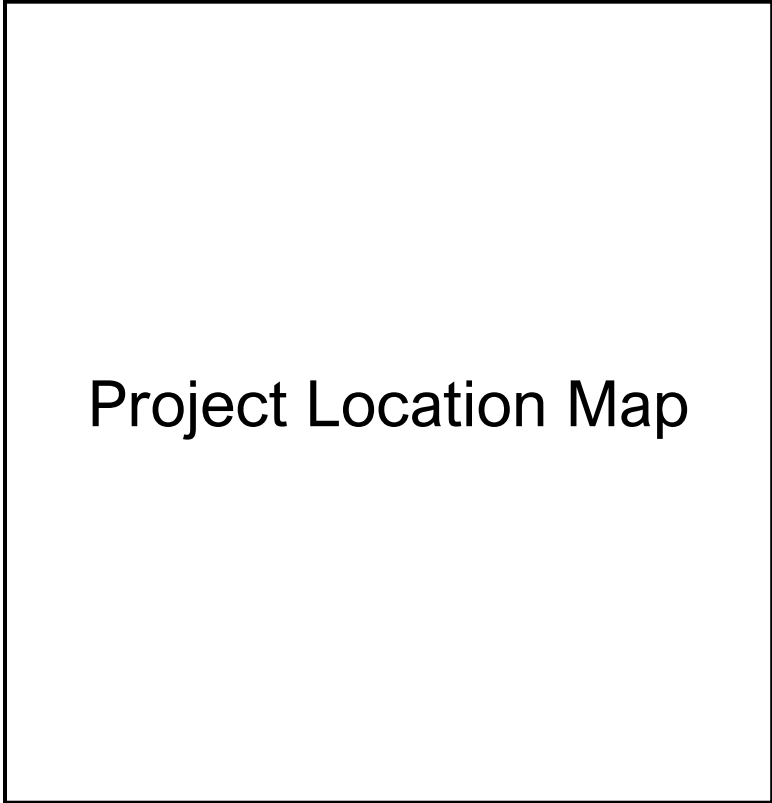


The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites you to a public hearing for the (study name) Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study, FPID (number).


