




George T Lewis Airport (CDK) is a general aviation (GA) airport located in Cedar Key along Florida's central Gulf Coast. CDK is owned and operated by Levy County and has one single asphalt runway (5-23) that is 2,302 long by 75 feet wide.

Perched at the tip of Cedar Key, CDK is surrounded by pristine waters and scenic natural preserves. Cedar Key and the surrounding area is home to several historic attractions, popular restaurants, and resorts, making CDK a popular destination for leisure travelers. While there are no onsite businesses, the airport plays a vital role in the local economy by providing a gateway for out-of-state travelers to access the city.

Cedar Key hosts a variety of annual events, such as the Arts Festival, Seafood Festival, and Cedar Key Pirate Invasion that attract visitors from around Florida and beyond. CDK primarily supports recreational GA traffic with occasional use from corporate aircraft bringing workers and high-profile executives into Cedar Key. In addition, the airport supports critical missions for the community, as it is frequently used as a staging area for search and rescue operations. The airport also regularly serves air ambulance aircraft performing emergency medical evacuations to transport patients from Cedar Key to larger hospitals providing specialized or sophisticated medical treatments.
