




Wauchula Municipal Airport (CHN) is a general aviation (GA) airport located approximately five miles southwest of Wauchula in south-central Florida. The single paved runway (18-36) is 4,005 feet long and 75 feet wide.

The airport frequently accommodates traffic from recreational GA pilots and passengers, as well as business/corporate aviation. Visitors can enjoy a variety of recreational activities in Wauchula and nearby Zolfo Springs and Bowling Green. The area is home to several museums focusing on the history of central Florida; numerous natural preserves, parks, and wildlife refuges; and multiple golf courses.

Harvest Aviation occupies one of the largest hangar facilities at CHN. This non-profit organization operates flights that directly support missionary work in Central and South America. Additional services offered at CHN include aerial agricultural spraying and aircraft storage. CHN hosts the yearly Bensen Days event, a showcase of gyroplanes, helicopters, and experimental aircraft. The event is attended by members of the local community as well as visitors who fly in from across central Florida.
