

Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE) is a general aviation airport located approximately five miles from Florida's Atlantic Coast and six miles north of downtown Fort Lauderdale. The airport has two intersecting paved runways (9-27 and 13-31), the longest of which measures 6,002 feet long by 100 feet wide. FXE primarily serves corporate/business aviation. Four fixed-base operators (FBO) are onsite to support aircraft and their pilots and passengers, including the many high-profile travelers who arrive at the airport. Other aviation activities accommodated at FXE include flight training, air cargo, and law enforcement and wildlife protection operations.

FXE is in a designated Foreign Trade Zone (FTZ 241) with an onsite U.S. Customs and Border Protection facility. This valuable designation provides duty reduction, deferral, or elimination on merchandise in the zone – bringing high-wage jobs and economic development into the county. The airport hosts many community activities such as the Fort Lauderdale Air Show, Uptown 5k On the Runway fundraiser, and career events to promote aviation to aspiring young professionals.
