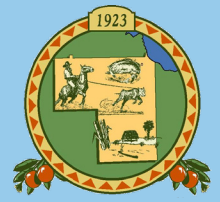

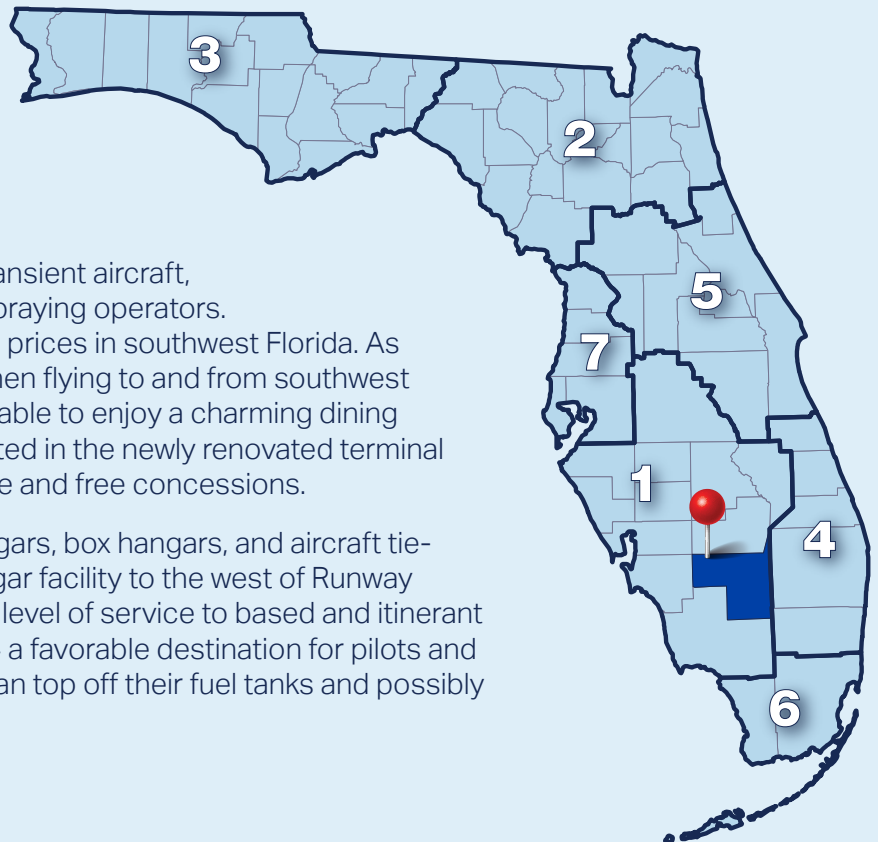

LaBelle Municipal Airport (X14) is a general aviation (GA) airport located within the City of LaBelle, between Fort Myers and West Palm Beach. The airport offers one paved runway that is 5,254 feet long by 75 feet wide (Runway 14-32).

The airport is a popular destination for many transient aircraft, local flight training providers, and agricultural spraying operators. The airport strives to provide the cheapest fuel prices in southwest Florida. As a result, many pilots choose to refuel at X14 when flying to and from southwest Florida. Visiting pilots and passengers are also able to enjoy a charming dining experience at Short Cakes, the restaurant located in the newly renovated terminal building. The terminal also offers a pilot's lounge and free concessions.

Other amenities available at X14 include T-hangars, box hangars, and aircraft tie-downs. There is a new parallel taxiway and hangar facility to the west of Runway 14-32 that was constructed to offer a different level of service to based and itinerant pilots. These amenities and services make X14 a favorable destination for pilots and passengers looking for an airport where they can top off their fuel tanks and possibly spend the weekend visiting southwest Florida.

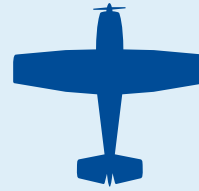

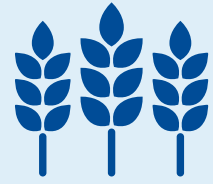

Overview of the FASP 2043 Update:

Per Florida statute, the Florida Aviation System Plan (FASP) is periodically updated to summarize the airport and aviation needs in Florida while remaining consistent with the goals of the Florida Transportation Plan (FTP). The FASP 2043 Update focuses on reviewing the applicability of the various goals, objectives, and performance measures to support two primary goals: 1) provide for more efficiency in decision making within FDOT to support funding and development decisions, and 2) provide airports within the system with recommendations for development that support their individual missions while contributing to the overall strength and health of the Florida airport system.
