

- » Project Limits & Study Area

    - 6 lanes; 8 lanes from SR 70 to Indrio Rd
  - 15 interchanges including Oslo Road interchange
  - Explore Multimodal Alternatives

    - Short Term
    - Long Term (2045)




### **Study Area – Indian River County**

» No Additional I-95 Capacity Needed in Indian River County


- » Add Managed Lane from Palm Beach/Martin county line to SR 70

# **Oslo Road Interchange Concept**


- » Currently under design

## SR 60 Interchange Concept


- » No interchange improvements needed

## Indian River MPO - Next Steps

- » Endorse I-95 Treasure Coast Master Plan's Recommendations
- » Add Fellsmere Road projects (2030 and 2045) onto
  - 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP), and
  - Include in MPO's future Priority Lists
- » Incorporate FDOT's List of SIS projects into 2045 LRTP
  - To include SR 60 ramp improvements
