On January 12, 2018, the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) Office of Inspector General (OIG) received a complaint from a former Jacksonville Transportation Authority (JTA) employee regarding mismanagement of State and Federal Transit Grant Awards.

The complainant reported JTA sought reimbursement for the payroll of a union leader who was allegedly performing union duties while claiming work and overtime pay for FDOT projects.

The OIG performed a review of this allegation by:

- interviewing the complainant;
- reviewing the invoices from contract number GOE27; and
- obtaining information from the FDOT contract manager.

We found that JTA has not requested reimbursement for maintenance technicians working on projects funded by FDOT grants. Therefore, we determined the allegation to be unsupported.
