TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – Due the re-opening of the Roosevelt Bridge and Dixie Highway, Florida's Turnpike is no longer a necessary detour route for 2-axle vehicles. Effective Monday, July 6, at 6am, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will reinstate tolls on Florida's Turnpike for all 2-axle vehicles. The Turnpike will remain a detour route for vehicles with 3 or more axles; therefore, tolls will remain suspended between milepost 133 (Monterey Rd) and milepost 142 (Port St. Lucie Blvd) for these larger vehicles.

Roosevelt Bridge and Dixie Highway Traffic Advisory

Trucks with 3 axles or more should refer to the attached regional detour map to safely navigate in and around the area.

All motorists are urged to avoid distractions, follow all posted signage, and drive safely.
