Weekend Lane Closures for Northbound Roosevelt Bridge

Down to one lane Saturday through Monday

STUART, Fla. – Northbound US-1 traffic over the Roosevelt Bridge will be reduced to one lane over the weekend just north of the Joan Jefferson intersection beginning Saturday night, December 19, at 8 p.m., until Monday, December 21, at 6 a.m. This work was previously scheduled for last weekend but was cancelled due to weather.

The lane closures will allow for sealing of the bridge deck at the south end of the bridge. Please note, Dixie Highway will remain open during this work and serve as an alternate route. Additionally, with the overall progress being made on the sealing of the northbound bridge, the bridge is expected to be restored to its final three-lane configuration next week, prior to the Christmas holiday.
