### LEE COUNTY

**US 41 Caloosahatchee Bridge:** Construction project: Crews continue to perform maintenance on the US 41 bridge over the Caloosahatchee River. Marine traffic should expect construction barges and activity in the area.

- **Motorists should expect both the northbound and southbound lanes over the Caloosahatchee River TO BE CLOSED to ALL TRAFFIC during nighttime/overnight hours from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., on Tuesday, January 17 through Friday, January 20 while crews install overhead signs, weather permitting. Detour signs will be in place. Motorists may use the Edison Bridge (SR 739/Business 41) during this time or seek alternate routes.**

Variable message signs are in place to alert drivers that work is underway. Boaters should use caution. Estimated project completion is early 2017. The contractor is Inland Construction & Equipment, Inc.
