Utility Vehicles are not permitted to cross







Single Panel Vans
must determine their GVW to be less than 10,000 lbs. before crossing.
(vehicle + cargo + equipment + passengers)















Box Trucks are not permitted to cross.







Small and Large Transit Vehicles are not permitted to cross.







Cars, Pick-up Trucks, and Sport Utility Vehicles (SUVs) are permitted to cross.



Passenger Vehicles / Pick-up Trucks / SUVs with Single Axle trailer rated up to 3,500 lbs. or with double axle trailer rated up to 7,000 lbs.






Passenger Vehicles / Pick-up Trucks / SUVs with Triple Axle trailers are not permitted to cross.
