I-75 AT MILE MARKER 34**



Stop in and visit the Wildlife Exhibit on the south side of Alligator Alley at mile marker 34. This exhibit will give the traveler a chance to learn about the largest subtropical wilderness in the United States. Also, stop by the overlook on the north side of the rest stop to see a bird's eye view of the Everglades. The Overlook also provides an excellent opportunity for wildlife viewing.
