

**ADDENDUM "A"**

**CONTRACT BE994**

**LOCAL AGREEMENT (FY20/21)**

This Local Agreement between the Florida Department of Transportation, District 3, Ponce de Leon Operations Center, hereinafter referred to as DOT, and the Florida Department of Corrections' Walton County Corrections Institute, hereinafter referred to as FDC, shall be made a part of Master Agreement #W1177/DOT BE994 between the above-mentioned agencies dated 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 2020.

DOT agrees to compensate FDC for inmate labor, as provided for by this Local Agreement, for maintenance activities listed in the Master Agreement Addendum "B" (attached). The estimated total amount of annual compensation for this Local Agreement is \$570,000.00

DOT agrees to supervise 0 community and/or minimum custody inmates as supplemental support labor.

FDC agrees to provide 6 correctional officers to supervise 30 inmates for labor to be performed as scheduled by DOT.

The workweek shall be as follows:

*Monday- Thursday 6:30am- 5:00 PM CST. Normal Lunch break will be from 12:00pm- 12:30pm. Time begins when the DC crews arrive at the Ponce de Leon Operations Center yard. If FDC does not arrive at the Ponce de Leon yard by 7:30am it is considered a no show and will not be compensated for that day.*

The Department of Transportation, District 3, Ponce de Leon Operations and the Department of Corrections' Walton County Prison/Work Camp mutually agree to schedule and provide correctional officers and inmate crews in excess of the number of officers and inmate crews scheduled per week, as specified in the Local Agreement. Work crews in excess of the number of work crews specified in the Local Agreement will be for the purpose of performing DOT identified work needs; payment will be at the regular hourly rate for inmates and travel time for officers (if needed). Overtime rates will not apply to the temporary additional work crews described herein.

Other provisions of this Local Agreement are as follows:

FDC shall provide notice to DOT within one (1) hour of work shift start time should an FDC Officer not be available to supervise assigned inmates on a scheduled workday.

FDC shall notify DOT in the event FDC cannot fulfill the obligations as described in this Local Agreement.

The effective dates of this Agreement are July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021. Provisions of this Local Agreement may be amended by written agreement of the parties.
