

**ADDENDUM "A"**

**CONTRACT# BE415**

**LOCAL AGREEMENT (FY2017/2018)**

This Local Agreement between Department of Transportation, District 4, Broward Operations Center or Maintenance Yard, hereinafter referred to as DOT, and the Department of Corrections' South Florida Reception Center, hereinafter referred to as FDC, shall be an attachment to and made a part of the Master Agreement between the above-mentioned agencies dated 25th day of June, 2017.

**DOT agrees to compensate FDC for inmate labor the estimated amount of \$430,118.00 as provided for by this Local Agreement for the following activities:**

DOT agrees to supervise eight (8) to fifteen (15) community and/or minimum custody inmates as supplemental support labor.

FDC agrees to provide four (4) correctional officers to supervise sixteen (16) to twenty (20) inmates for labor to be performed as scheduled by DOT.

The workweek shall be as follows:

6:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. No Crews shall work on State Holidays and weekends (Saturday and Sunday) unless otherwise authorized by the DOT.

Other provisions of this Local Agreement are as follows:

- DOT authorizes FDC to utilize a DOT owned bus as a means of transportation to and from SFRC, transporting all officers and inmates.
- FDC shall require all correctional officers operating DOT vehicles to hold a valid Commercial Driver's License as specified by Florida Statutes.
- FDC will only be compensated for each unit of work performed and satisfactorily completed.

- If additional inmates or crews are provided beyond those requested by DOT, compensation will only be authorized if the DOT agrees to supervise them.
- FDC shall provide notice to DOT within one (1) hour of work shift start time should a correctional officer not be available to supervise their assigned inmates on any given work day.
- FDC shall notify DOT in the event FDC cannot fulfill contractual obligations as described in this Agreement.

The effective dates of this Agreement are July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018. Provisions of this Local Agreement may be amended by written agreement of the parties.
