Containment Steps	Non-Reportable Spill	Reportable Spill
 Proceed if you feel safe! Stay up wind of spill Wear proper PPE Set up cones or barricades Place absorbents on spill Divert spill away from inlets or bodies of water 	 Known material Can be safely contained On impervious service Does not enter waters 	 Unknown material Do not feel safe Into waters or storm sewer Spills requiring state notification
