## **Reporting Procedures for Spill Response**



<b>Containment Steps</b>	Non-Reportable Spill	Reportable Spill
<ol> <li>Proceed if you feel safe!</li> <li>Stay up wind of spill</li> <li>Wear proper PPE</li> <li>Set up cones or barricades</li> <li>Place absorbents on spill</li> <li>Divert spill away from inlets or bodies of water</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Known material</li> <li>Can be safely contained</li> <li>On impervious service</li> <li>Does not enter waters</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Unknown material</li> <li>Do not feel safe</li> <li>Into waters or storm sewer</li> <li>Spills requiring state notification</li> </ol>
