**HURRICANE MICHAEL
FIFTH AMENDED EMERGENCY ORDER
(Pursuant to Executive Order No. 18-276, 18-360, 19-33 and 19-98)**

I hereby find that the Department of Transportation's timely performance of disaster response functions related to the Hurricane Michael is continued to be hindered by the application of procedures imposed by statute, rule, or order.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority granted by Section 4 of Executive Orders 18-276 and 18-277 as extended by Executive Orders 18-360, 19-33 and 19-98, I hereby suspend the effect of any statute, rule, or order, as needed to suspend the size and weight restrictions for divisible loads on any vehicles transporting Hurricane Michael damaged timber and other silviculture products from Okaloosa, Walton, Holmes, Washington, Bay, Jackson, Calhoun, Gulf, Gadsden, Liberty, Franklin, Leon, Wakulla and Jefferson Counties, as recommended by the Commissioner of Agriculture and allowing the establishment of alternative size and weight restrictions for all such vehicles by permit.

This order shall expire on the earlier of the expiration or rescission of Executive Order 18-276 and as amended by Executive Order 18-360, 19-33 and 19-98 or May 16, 2019, unless extended by me.
