SUBJECT: Rescission of Emergency Road Use Permit – Hurricane Sally

On June 4, 2021, pursuant to the authority conferred by Executive Order 20-224, Executive Order 20-248, and Executive Order 21-104, Secretary Thibault signed the Hurricane Sally Twelfth Emergency Order. In accordance with these orders, an Emergency Road Use Permit Letter was issued on June 6, 2021, with an expiration date of July 6, 2021, unless rescinded by the Secretary.

On June 17, 2021, Secretary Thibault signed an order rescinding the July 6, 2021, expiration date of the Hurricane Sally Emergency Road Use Permit Letter.

In accordance with the Secretary's Hurricane Sally Rescission Order, the Emergency Road Use Permit Letter issued pursuant to Executive Orders 20-224, 20-248, 21-104 and the Secretary's Twelfth Emergency Order has been rescinded and is set to expire effective 6:00 a.m. CST on Sunday, June 20, 2021. The Emergency Road Use Permit Letter will not be honored beyond this date and time.
