NOTICE OF TRUCK DETOUR

WILSON PIGOTT BRIDGE

State Road 31 (S.R. 31) over the
Caloosahatchee River

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is addressing ongoing maintenance concerns with the Wilson Pigott Bridge on S.R. 31 over the Caloosahatchee River. In response to these concerns and to ensure public safety, FDOT will implement the following measures.



Commercial Truck Restriction: Beginning November 17, 2025, Commercial Truck traffic will be prohibited from using the Wilson Pigott Bridge. Passenger vehicles may continue to use the bridge.



Detour Route: Commercial Trucks will be rerouted to use I-75 to cross the Caloosahatchee River as an alternative to S.R. 31. **See detour route on back.**



Bridge Deck Reconstruction: FDOT has plans to reconstruct the bridge deck, with a tentative completion date set for March 2026.



Detour Duration: The Commercial Truck detour will remain in effect until the bridge deck replacement is complete.



FDOT will coordinate with the trucking industry and media outlets to ensure awareness of this detour to minimize disruptions. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding as we work to maintain the safety and reliability of Florida's transportation infrastructure.

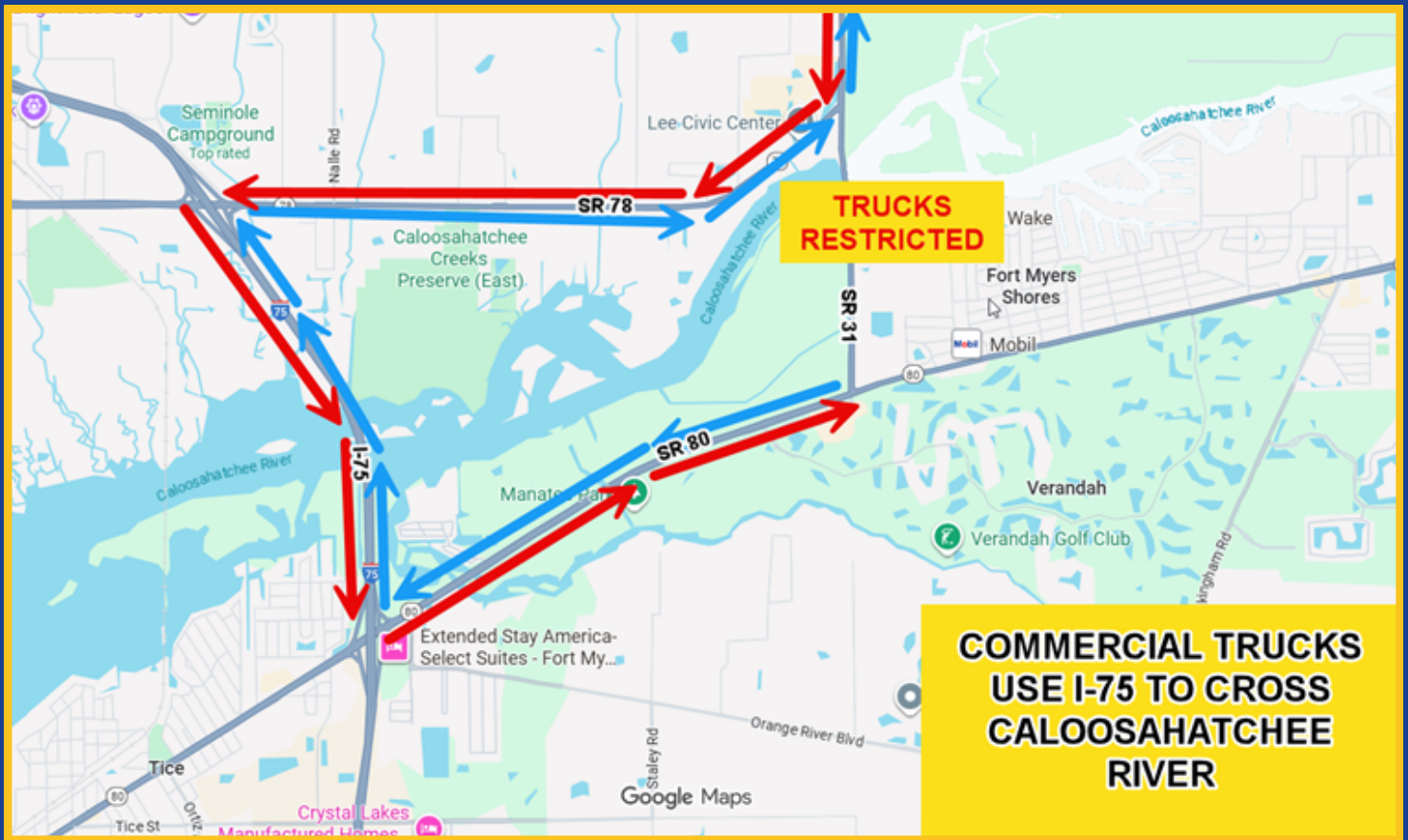
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DETOUR ROUTE
