## Mobility Week 2019

The State of Florida celebrated its second annual statewide Mobility Week with roaring success from Oct 25–Nov 1, 2019.

Mobility Week is a cooperative effort by FDOT and partners to promote awareness of safe multimodal transportation choices. During this week, partner agencies host events to collectively share information with the public about transportation choices and safety.

FDOT partnered with 235 local agencies to organize 193 events in 53 counties. A Mix-It-Up challenge was organized to encourage people to try a new transportation choice during the week. 172 people participated in the challenge.

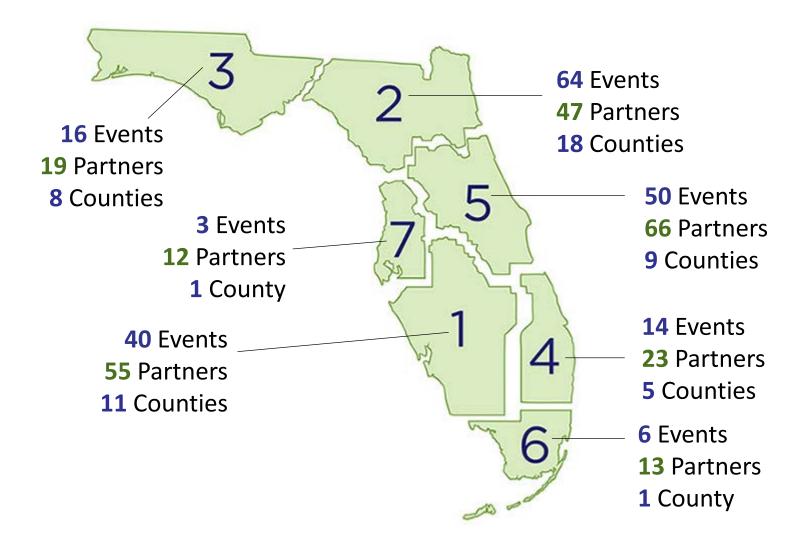
