## Safety tips for bicycling

- On Halloween like every bicycle ride, ensure you're wearing reflective and light colored clothing and costume.
- Double check that front and back lights are functioning properly and your helmet is fitted snug.
- If you're going to pedal in costume, choose something less likely to get caught in your wheels.
- If a crash does occur, call 911 to at minimum ensure it is reported, and in the worst case any safety and health emergency can be attended.
