


EMERGENCY RIDE HOME

Use the RideOn app to log at least 3 trips per week to work or school by: carpool/vanpool, bus, bike or walking. Tell RideOn to sync with your phone's GPS or any fitness tracker--and record your trips automatically!

If illness or unexpected overtime disrupts your usual way home, you simply activate the Emergency icon. The system verifies your qualifying trips and immediately sends an authorization code. You get a quick, safe cab ride home and RideOn gets the bill.



WE'VE GOT YOU COVERED!

I pool with my spouse. Does that count?

Yes; any 2 adults who pool to work or school at least 3 days per week qualify.

What's defined as an emergency?

Something unforeseen that disrupts your usual trip home, like illness or unexpected overtime. If you have an appointment or know your driver will be on vacation, that doesn't qualify. You need to make other arrangements.

Can I use it to get to work?

No. The purpose of the ERH is to get you safely home in the event of an emergency.

Am I limited to a certain number of uses?

Fortunately, most ERHP members discover they rarely--if ever--actually need it. If an unusual number is being used (3+ in a year), each request will need to be approved by the program manager.

If it's free to me, who pays?

The Emergency Ride Home Program is funded by a grant from the Florida Department of Transportation, to encourage the use of sustainable commute choices.
