Why is this important to FDOT?


 Advance and raise public awareness of the objectives of the Florida Transportation Plan


- The first annual Ride Roll Stroll Challenge was held during Mobility Week 2023 from Oct. 27 through Nov. 30
- Thanks to 1,035 active members representing 223 organizations across Florida, 17,934 multimodal trips were recorded

Transit trips: 6,443

Bike trips: 2,683

Walk trips: 2,518 trips

Car/vanpool: 6,290 trips






RIDEROLL STROLL CHALLENGE

CAP Insights

- District 1's Commute Connector program saw a 109% increase in participation
- District 5's reThink Your Commute program had a 40% increase in participation
- Commute Tampa Bay had a 28% increase in participation
- Total recorded trips, all brands = 42% higher
- Collectively, the CAPs enrolled 125 new members in November 2022; in November 2023, they enrolled 223 new members


