# 2022 Program Changes

- Based on Committee survey results and discussion at the January Meeting
- Expanded project type eligibility
  - SHS Roadway
  - Non-SHS Roadway (New)
  - Truck Parking (New)
  - Intermodal Logistics Center Access (New)
  - Rail (New)
- Guidance added:
  - Off-system projects should be focused on identifying potential additions to the National Highway Freight Network (NHFN)







## Submitted Project Types





