What is it?

The purpose of the <u>SCOP Municipalities (MSCOP)</u> program authorized under section 339.2818 of Florida Statutes provides assistance to municipalities and communities in repairing or rehabilitating local bridges, paving unpaved roads, addressing road-related drainage improvements, resurfacing or reconstructing local roads, or constructing capacity or safety improvements to local roads.

MSCOP applications are reviewed and selected through the FDOT Central Office (CO) in Tallahassee.
