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1.0 Parks and Public Land

1.1 Legal and Regulatory Context

The U.S. Department of Transportation Act of 1966, Section 4(f) prohibits the use of land from a significant publicly owned public park, recreation area, or wildlife and waterfowl refuge, or any significant historic site unless a determination is made that:

- There is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of land from the property.
- The action includes all possible planning to minimize harm to the property resulting from such use.

1.2 Methodology

A database search was performed in January 2008, April 2010 and again in February 2012 to inventory all existing public lands within one-quarter mile of the study corridor, including community, neighborhood, urban use, county, and city parks. GIS data was retrieved from the City of Fort Lauderdale, Broward County, and the Florida Geographic Data Library (FGDL). These datasets were queried for one-quarter mile adjacency to the study corridor, and addresses were checked against parks information on Broward County, the City of Fort Lauderdale, the City of Plantation, and the City of Lauderhill's websites.

As the Study alignments have evolved and been modified, this report has been updated and revised to reflect parklands and recreation areas potentially affected by the addition of new study areas. Most of the parks are located on the east end of the study corridor, where the proposed transit route runs through a more suburban area and across several waterways. Amenities of the identified parks vary from boat ramps, basketball courts, and education facilities to small urban greenspaces with simple picnic areas.

1.3 Western Segment Parks and Public Land

Three park areas were identified immediately surrounding the Western Segment. All three are located on the west side of Hiatus Road with the largest, Markham Park, located on the edge of the Everglades. Despite its large size, only a small portion of Markham Park falls within the study corridor. The park is located on the west side of the Sawgrass Expressway, and would not be impacted by the proposed alignment. Exhibit 1 lists the parks and public land in the Western Segment, while Exhibit 2 shows their locations.

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
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Exhibit 2: Western Segment Parks and Public Land Map





1.4 Central Griffin Road Segment Parks and Public Land

Eleven park areas were identified immediately surrounding the Central Griffin Road Segment. Most of these are relatively centrally located within the segment, and are found along both sides of Griffin Road. The two exceptions to this pattern are Wes Griffin Park Playground, located just north of Nova Drive, and Tigertail Park, located south of where Griffin Road crosses the CSX Rail Corridor. Exhibit 3 lists the parks and public land in the Central Griffin Road Segment, while Exhibit 4 shows their locations.

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
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Exhibit 4: Central Griffin Road Segment Parks and Public Land Map





1.5 Central SR 7/Broward Boulevard Segment Parks and Public Land

Ten park areas were identified immediately surrounding the Central SR 7/Broward Boulevard Segment. These are found in three main areas along the corridor: the first being north of Nova Drive and west of Davie Road, the second on both sides of SR 7 south of Davie Boulevard, and the third on both sides of Broward Boulevard east of SW 31st Avenue. Pond Apple Slough, located to the southwest of the I-595/SR 7 interchange is another large park that falls only slightly within the study corridor, and would consequently not be impacted by the proposed alignment. Exhibit 5 lists the parks and public land in the Central SR 7/Broward Boulevard Segment, while Exhibit 6 shows their locations.


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Exhibit 6: Central SR 7/Broward Boulevard Segment Parks and Public Land Map





1.6 Eastern Segment Parks and Public Land

Twenty-two park areas were identified immediately surrounding the Eastern Segment. This is by far the segment with the most parks and public land. The majority of these are located in the northern part of the segment, in or around downtown Fort Lauderdale. Although fewer parks are located south of SR84, the parks that are found here are much bigger due to the less dense development patterns allowing for more open space. Exhibit 7 lists the parks and public land in the Eastern Segment, while Exhibit 8 shows their locations.
