

Acquisition and Restoration Council (ARC) Process/Status

- Project will impact 2.5 acres of FDEP's Sebastian Inlet State Park.
- FDOT to acquire a FDEP Easement through the Division of State Lands and Acquisition and Restoration Council (ARC).
- FDOT has coordinated with FDEP (Division of State Lands and FDEP Park Manager) during both the PD&E Study and design phase to minimize permanent impacts to park.
- FDOT to conduct presentation to the ARC Council in December 2024.
- FDOT is continuing to pursue FDEP Easement through coordination with Division of State Lands and Park staff.
- FDOT has proposed enhancements to offset 2.5 acres of park impacts.

Park Enhancements and Mitigation

FDOT To provide the following as part of park enhancements and mitigation for both the ARC Easement and Section 4(f):

- Six Scenic Overlooks
- South and North fishing piers
- Bicycle Lanes
- Shared Use Paths
- Extended left and right turn lanes into park
- Southbound acceleration lane
- Improvements to South and North Parking Lots (repaving lots and adding additional parking spaces)
- Accommodations for delivery trucks at North Parking Lots
- Increased pedestrian access points (cut throughs) on North Parking Lot
- Improvements to drainage system
- Shoreline Protection Measures at eastern edge of swimming cove
- Replacement of perimeter fence around bridge at north side of bridge
- Funds to add electronic gates at south and north park entrances
