# INTRODUCTION



## Purpose

This document presents county-to-county work flows for all 67 counties in Florida based on the 2012-2016 American Community Survey/Census Transportation Planning Product (ACS/CTPP) data released by US Census Bureau in March 2019.

## The ACS/CTPP Data

CTPP is a data program sponsored by AASHTO with funding contributions from all state DOTs and some MPOs. The data program is also supported by US Census Bureau, FHWA, FTA, TRB, and the Research and Innovative Technology Administration (RITA). The CTPP program began in 1960 with the 1960 US Census. Prior to 2005, CTPP data products were based on decennial Census long form Summary File 3 (SF3). The census long form has since been replaced with a continuous survey called the American Community Survey (ACS). The CTPP now uses the ACS sample for data tabulation.

The ACS/CTPP data products include the following:

- Transportation Profiles for states, counties, and cities/Census Designated Places (CDPs)
- Three-year commuting data tabulations at county level for counties with population over 20,000
- Five-year commuting data tabulations at census tract and Transportation Analysis Zone (TAZ) level
- National Report on Commuting Patterns and Trends

The CTPP tabulations include three (3) parts:

- Part 1: Residence-based tabulations summarizing worker and household characteristics
- Part 2: Workplace-based tabulations summarizing worker characteristics
- Part 3: Worker flows between home and work, including means of transportation, travel time, and many other measures

The ACS/CTPP data is released periodically and at different geographic levels. Only the 5-year data has the geographic details that allow users to perform analysis for areas smaller than county. The most recent 5-year ACS/CTPP data available is for 2012-2016. The county-to-county flows presented here are based on Part 3: Worker Flows of the 2012-2016 ACS/CTPP data. 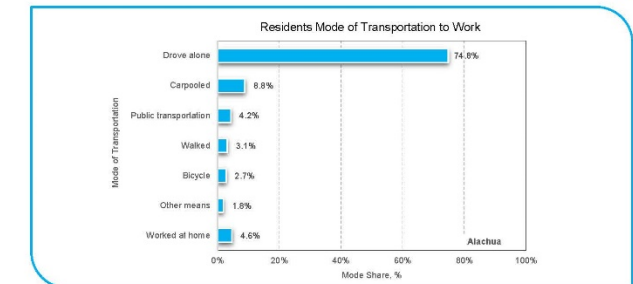
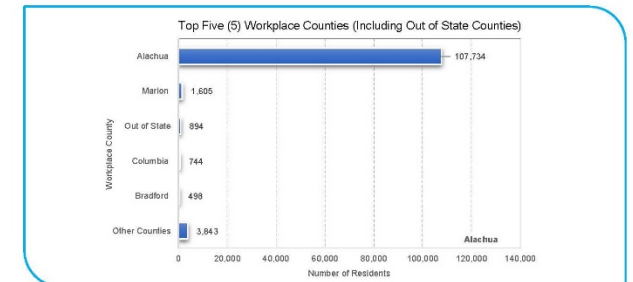
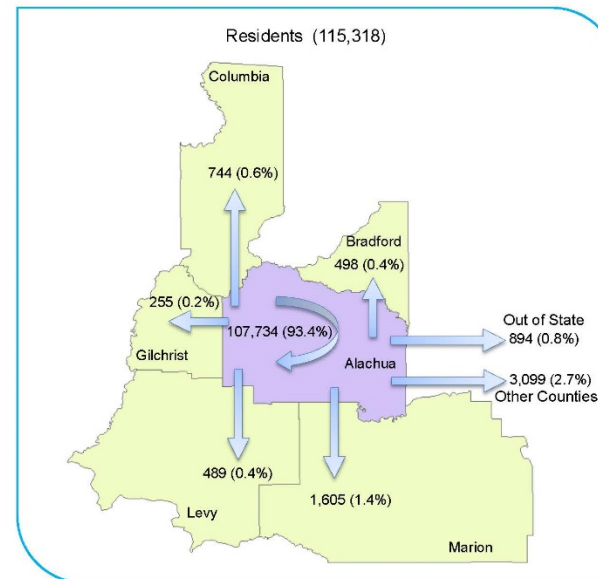
# INTRODUCTION

## Guide to Read the Travel Pattern Data

The county-to-county work flows for each county are presented in two separate slides. One slide shows the work flows for workers that reside in the subject county and work both in and out of the county. The slide is titled “(County Name) Work Flows – County Residents.” The figure on the right shows such a slide for Alachua County as an example. On each slide, there is a map on the left-hand side showing the county and its neighboring counties with arrows representing the direction of travel (outbound for county residents) and numbers representing the magnitude of travel. On the right-hand side, there are two horizontal bar charts. The one on the top lists the top five (5) workplace counties (including out-of-state flows and flows to other counties) in descending order. It is worth mentioning that the map on the left does not necessarily reflect the top chart on the right. The map only shows the patterns between the county in discussion and its immediate neighboring counties. The one at the bottom shows the Means of Transportation the resident workers used to go to work. Using Alachua as example, there were on average 115,318 workers that lived in Alachua County per year between 2012 and 2016. The majority of them, 107,734, or 93.4%, were employed within Alachua County. Marion County employed the largest number of Alachua residents outside Alachua County with 1,605 (1.4%). There were 894 (0.8%) residents that worked out of the state. “Drove Alone” (79.4%) was the predominant mode of transportation to work. About 4.6% of people worked from home.

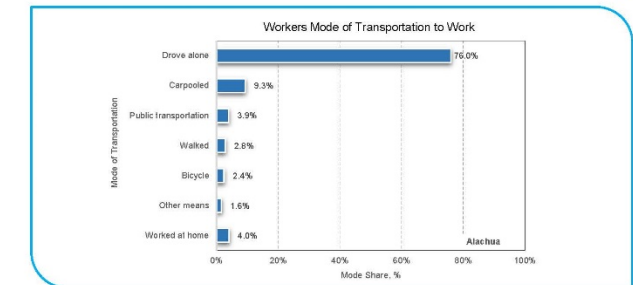
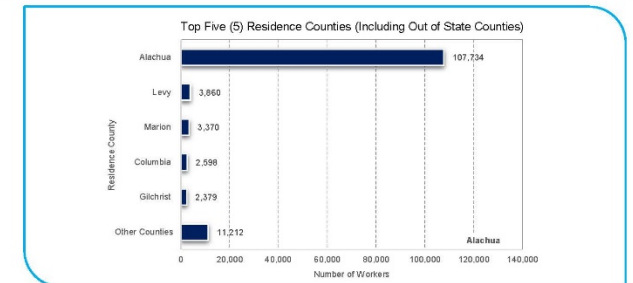
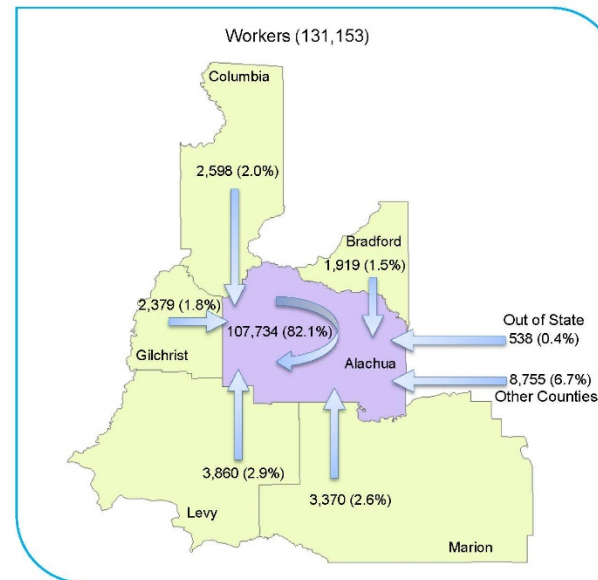

## Guide to Read the Travel Pattern Data (Continued)

The other slide shows the work flows for workers that are employed in the subject county and reside both in and out of the county. The slide is titled “(County Name) Work Flows – County **Workers**.” The figure on the right shows the same example for Alachua County. Like the slide for county residents, there is also a map on the left-hand side showing the county and its neighboring counties with arrows representing the direction of travel (inbound for county workers) and numbers representing the magnitude of travel. Similar to the work flow map for county residents, the map on the left does not necessarily reflect the top chart on the right. The map only shows the patterns between the county in discussion and its immediate neighboring counties. On the right-hand side, there are also two horizontal bar charts. The top chart lists the top five (5) residence counties in descending order. The bottom chart shows the Means of Transportation the workers used to travel to the subject county to work. In the case of Alachua County, there were on average 131,153 workers that were employed in Alachua County per year between 2012 and 2016. Out of the 18% Alachua employees who commuted from other counties and other states, most of them were residents of Levy, Marion, Columbia and Gilchrist counties. Alachua County had a job surplus of 15,835 (131,153-115,318) positions. “Drove Alone” (76.0%) was the predominant mode of transportation to work, followed by carpool with 9.3%.
