



# FLORIDA POPULATION AND EMPLOYMENT GROWTH

Historic and Projected Growth by County

With its remarkable beaches, weather, tourist attractions, and forward-thinking policies, it's no secret that Florida is an amazing place to live, raise a family, retire, and vacation. Over the past several years, Florida has experienced exponential growth both in the number of people who call Florida home as well as those who come to visit. In fact, nearly 1,000 people move to Florida daily. As of July 2022, estimated population in the state is 22.7 million, and over 118 million travelers visited the state in 2021, all of whom depend upon a safe, reliable, and innovative transportation system.

As the nation's third most populous state, Florida has grown over 16% during the past decade. With limitless opportunities for its residents, Florida's growth isn't slowing down, and the population is expected to cross 27 million by the year 2045. Employment has grown by 31% over the past decade, resulting in close to 13 million jobs in the state, and is expected to increase by another 49% by the year 2045. This growth will continue to be felt in every corner of the state.

To prepare for this continued growth and ensure Florida remains successful, we need to proactively plan for a safe and congestion-free transportation system that ensures the mobility of people and goods, enhances economic prosperity, and preserves the quality of our environment and communities.

This map series provides information on population and employment growth that occurred over the last decade at a county level and paints the picture of anticipated future growth through the year 2045. These maps will help support visioning exercises between FDOT and its partners as sustainable and enhanced transportation solutions are being considered.

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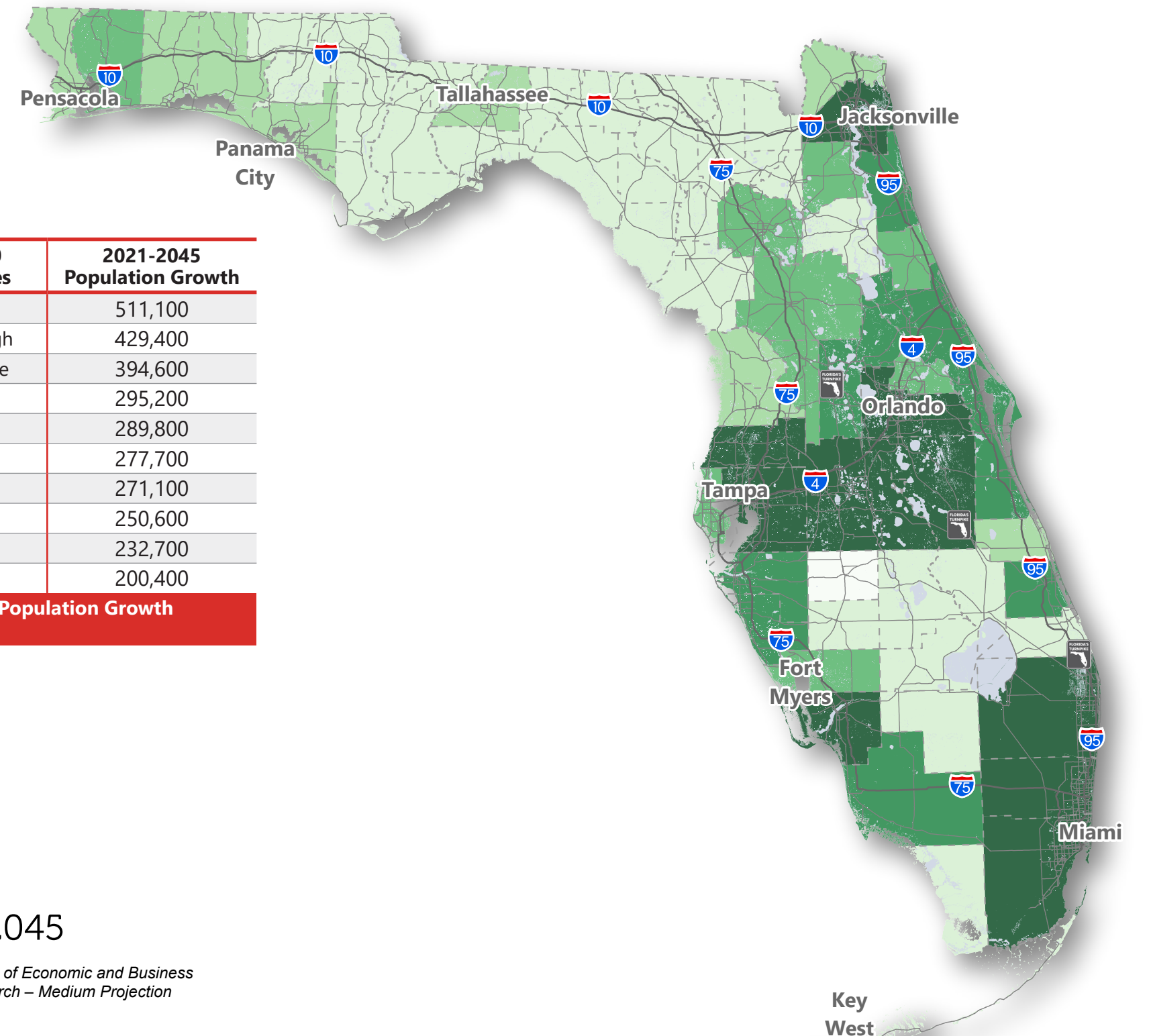
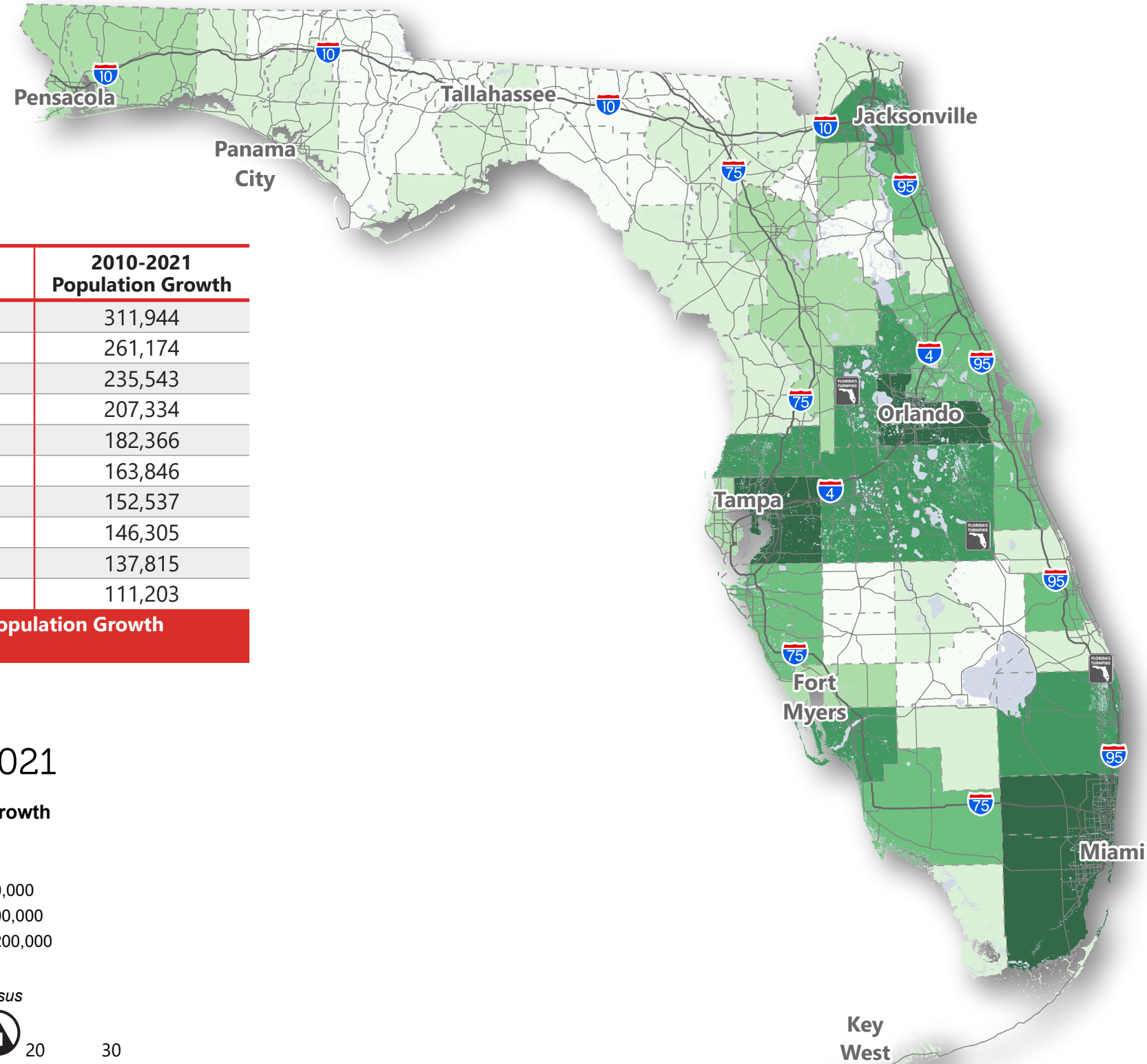

## POPULATION PERCENTAGE GROWTH



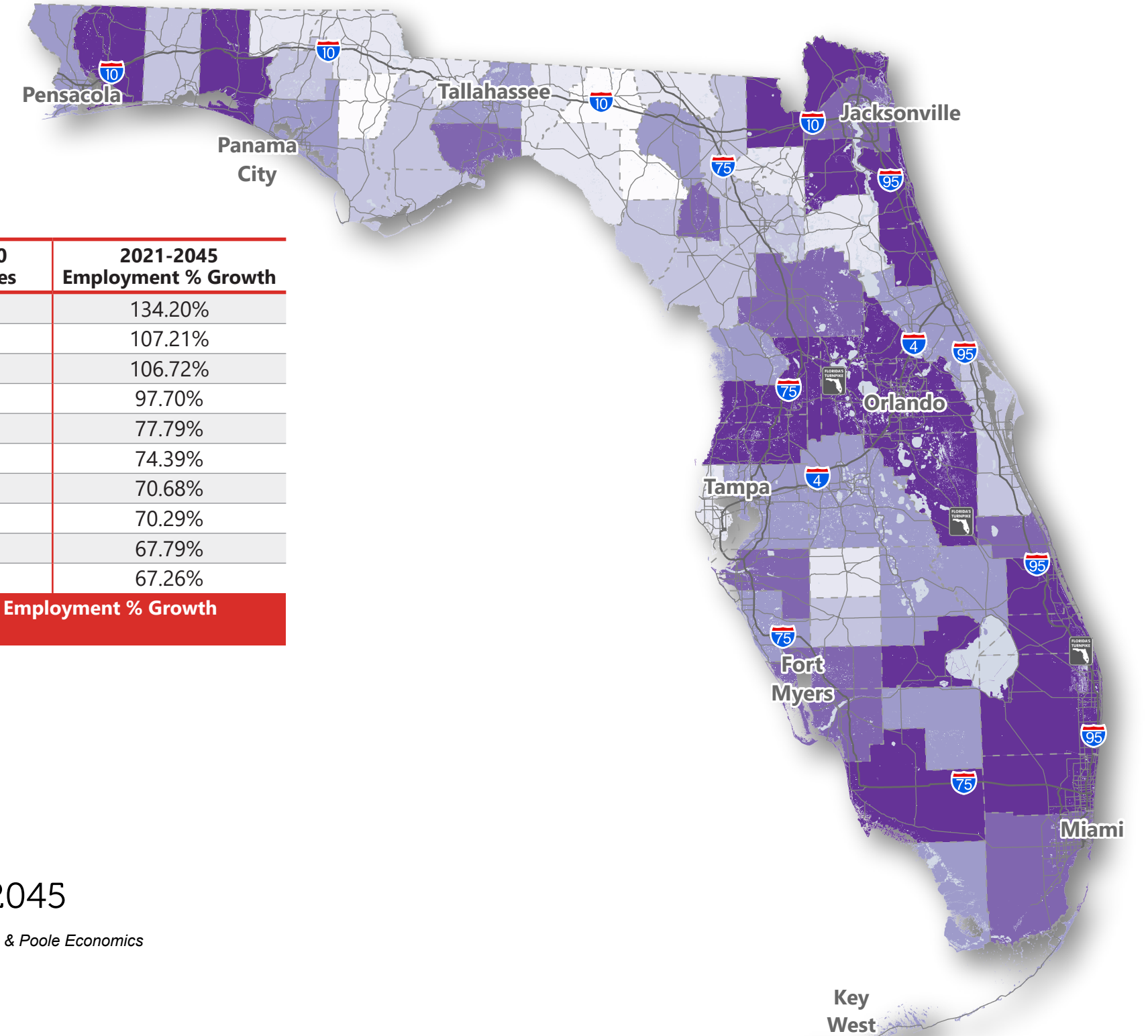
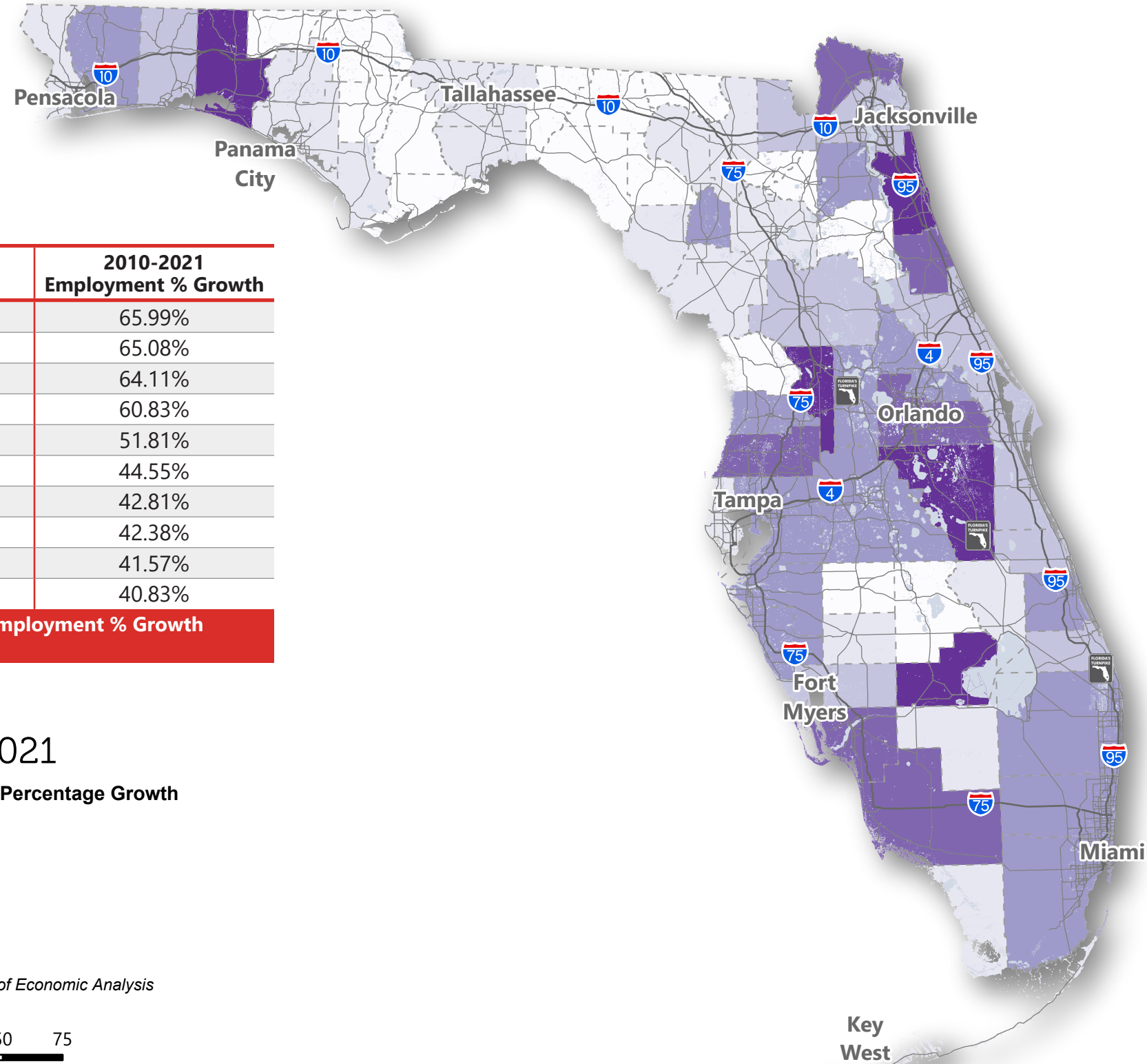
