

Notes

Heavy congestion in Urban Areas is defined as traffic that is either moving "bumper to bumper" or traffic that is "stop and go" during peak periods (Level of Service E or worse).

Heavy congestion in Non-Urban Areas is defined as heavy passenger and truck traffic during peak periods, characterized by difficulty in changing lanes (Level of Service D or worse).

Strategic Intermodal System (SIS) highways are priority facilities that represent the state's primary means for moving people and freight. SIS Planned Add facilities are not included in this brochure.
