

SUN Trail Funding Fact Sheet **Pierson Trail**

The Florida Department of Transportation completed design and construction of a 12-foot-wide Shared-Use Nonmotorized (SUN) Trail funded project along the east side of U.S. 17 (also known as State Road 15 and North Center Street) from Washington Avenue to Palmetto Avenue, to coincide with opening the elementary school in August 2018. Implementation of this trail addresses a need identified in the 2008 Pierson/Seville Elementary School Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Study. The project extends just over one-mile from the school, south past the Municipal Airport, and connects to the sidewalk on Washington Avenue, which provides access to the Volusia County's Votran Bus Route (Pierson/Seville) and to the baseball fields at Nixon Park on Chipper Jones Lane. The \$1.1 million trail gives students an opportunity to increase their physical activity by walking or bicycling between their homes, the school and the park.

Established during the 2015 legislative session and administered by the Florida Department of Transportation, the SUN Trail program receives \$25 million annually, from new vehicle tag fees, to expand the statewide system of paved multi-use trails (SUN Trail network) for bicyclists and pedestrians. The SUN Trail network aligns to the statewide Florida Greenways and Trails System Plan's Land Trail Priority network. Location of this project is along major networks including:

- St. Johns River-to-Sea-Loop, which is a developing 260-mile regional trail system that will link the Tri-County Agritourism Corridor to the Space Coast. See: sjr2c.org
- A Complimentary Route of the East Coast Greenway, which is a developing 3,000-mile national trail system that will link communities along the eastern seaboard from Key West, Florida to Calais, Maine.
