8 A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SENATE BILL 382,
9 DESIGNATING A PORTION OF STATE ROAD 109/
10 UNIVERSITY BOULEVARD BETWEEN CLIFTON AVENUE
11 AND FORT CAROLINE ROAD IN DUVAL COUNTY AS THE
12 "JIM TULLIS MEMORIAL BOULEVARD"; DIRECTING THE
13 CHIEF OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES TO SEND A COPY
14 OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT
15 OF TRANSPORTATION, DUVAL LEGISLATIVE
16 DELEGATION, THE SENATE PRESIDENT AND THE
17 SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
18 DATE.

20 **WHEREAS**, during the 2018 Legislative Session, the Florida
21 Legislature passed Senate Bill 382, which makes honorary
22 designations of transportation facilities through Florida and
23 directs the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to erect
24 suitable markers for those designations; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 382 designates that portion of State Road
26 109/University Boulevard between Clifton Avenue and Fort Caroline
27 Road as the "Jim Tullis Memorial Boulevard"; and

28 **WHEREAS**, Section 334.071, *Florida Statutes*, provides that a
29 city or county must pass a resolution in support of a particular
30 designation before road markers are erected; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the City of Jacksonville wishes to honor Jim Tullis
2 and requests that the Florida Department of Transportation erect
3 suitable markers designating the portion of State Road
4 109/University Boulevard between Clifton Avenue and Fort Caroline
5 Road as the "Jim Tullis Memorial Boulevard"; now therefore

6 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

7 **Section 1.** The City Council strongly supports Senate Bill
8 382, and designation of a portion of State Road 109/University
9 Boulevard between Clifton Avenue and Fort Caroline Road as the "Jim
10 Tullis Memorial Boulevard."

11 **Section 2. Direction to Chief of Legislative Services.**
12 The Chief of Legislative Services for the City Council is hereby
13 directed to provide a copy of this resolution to the Florida
14 Department of Transportation, Duval County Legislative Delegation,
15 Senate President and the Speaker of the House.

16 **Section 3. Effective Date.** That this Resolution shall
17 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming
18 effective without the Mayor's signature.
