Evaluation of Standard Waterborne Paint materials may be performed utilizing data submitted by an independent testing organization, such as the National Transportation Product Evaluation Program (NTPEP), in lieu of Product Evaluation testing from Part B above.

Do not add another sentence for acceptance of testing for Standard Paint to 971-1.4, Simply add "and Part C" to the FM5-541 statement below. Part C of FM5-541 already refers to acceptance of NTPEP testing. 971-1 General Requirements. 971-1.4 Approved Product List (APL): All pavement marking materials shall be one of the products listed on the Department's Approved Product List (APL). Manufacturers seeking evaluation of their product shall submit an application in accordance with Section 6 and the infrared identification curve (2.5 to 15 µm) for the vehicle component. The Department will test all pavement marking materials in accordance with FM 5-541, Part B and Part C. A notation of the number of coats and the thickness of each coat at which the product passes testing may be placed on the APL. When listed, this will be the minimum criteria for application of the pavement marking material.
