Response: Updated

Revise the 3rd and 4th sentences in 5-1.7 to read, "A Request for Information is not considered a Notice of Claim. Notices of Claim must be submitted in accordance with 5-12.2"

Response: Updated

Under 5-1.8, first paragraph, last sentence. revise to read, "Major modifications must be submitted as a Cost Savings Initiative Proposal."

Response: Updated

Same section, revise the 2nd paragraph to read, "Minor modifications are those items that, in the opinion of the Engineer, do not significantly affect the quantity of measured work, or the integrity or maintainability of the structure or its components. Strike the sentence in parenthesis beginning with, "For example".

Response: Sentence in parentheses deleted.

Recommend striking the definition of "major changes". Anything that is not "minor" is "major" by default.

Response: Definition of major changes deleted.
