

EXPECTED IMPLEMENTATION JANUARY 2022

971 PAVEMENT MARKING MATERIALS (REV 6-7-21) (FA 8-4-21) (1-22)

SUBARTICLE 971-1.4 is deleted and the following substituted:

971-1.4 Approved Product List (APL): All pavement marking materials shall be one of the products listed on the Department's Approved Product List (APL). Manufacturers seeking evaluation of their product shall submit an application in accordance with Section 6 and the infrared identification curve (2.5 to 15 μm) for the vehicle component. The Department will test standard thermoplastic and profiled thermoplastic pavement marking materials in accordance with FM 5-541, Part B. For standard paint, durable paint, preformed thermoplastic, two reactive component material, high friction thermoplastic, and permanent tape, manufacturers shall provide National Transportation Product Evaluation Program (NTPEP) field test data meeting FDOT Specification requirements. A notation of the number of coats and the thickness of each coat at which the product passes testing may be placed on the APL. When listed, this will be the minimum criteria for application of the pavement marking material.

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
