CHANNELIZING DEVICE MATERIALS (REV 5-10-21)

SUBARTICLE 991-1.2 is deleted and the following substituted:

991-1.2 Dimensions: The post shall have a minimum diameter of 3 inches. The base of the tubular marker shall have a maximum <u>diameter</u>, <u>width</u>, <u>or length</u> <u>dimension in any direction</u> of 8 inches. The height of the tubular marker above the pavement surface shall be 36 inches.

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
