## LEGAL REQUIREMENTS AND RESPONSIBILITY TO THE PUBLIC (REV 11-5-18)

ARTICLE 7-15 is deleted and the following substituted:

## 7-15 Opening Sections of the WorkHighway to Traffic.

Whenever any bridge or section of the Workroadway is in acceptable condition for usetravel, the Engineer may direct the Contractor to open it to vehicular or pedestrian traffic. The Department's direction to open a bridge or section of the Work-roadway does not constitute an acceptance of the Work bridge or roadway, or any part thereof, or waive any Contract provisions. Perform all necessary repairs or renewals, on any section of the <u>Work-roadway or bridge</u> thus opened to traffic under <u>direction instructions</u> from the Engineer, due to defective material or work or to any cause other than ordinary wear and tear, pending completion and the Engineer's acceptance of the <u>roadway or bridge</u>, or other <u>W</u> work, at no expense to the Department.
