SUBARTICLE 527-3.1 is deleted and the following substituted:

527-3 Installation Procedures.

527-3.1 Surface Preparation and Installation: Prepare the surface in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations. Use only products and materials appropriate for the surface on which they will be applied. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, using materials and equipment recommended and approved by the manufacturer. <u>Install surface-applied tiles or mats as soon as the sidewalk concrete has cured using For surface applied tiles or mats, use adhesives applied over the entire surface and mechanical fasteners.</u>
