(REV 9-11-1810-2-18)

SUBARTICLE 711-4.2.3 is deleted and the following substituted:

711-4.2.3 Preformed Thermoplastic: Apply 0.125 inch or 125 mils of preformed thermoplastic material. Preformed thermoplastic shall be used for all-bicycle markings, and shared use path markings, 24 inch markings of the special emphasis crosswalks, route shields, ramp exit numbers, and roundabout informational markings, white dotted lines (2'-4') with trailing black contrast, and black contrast arrows, messages, and symbols.

Measure, record and certify on Department approved form and submit to the Engineer, the thickness of the pavement markings in accordance with FM 5-541.
