Section 9700000: The only real issue I see is in 9700000, under section 970-2.3 Class RPM's. There is no requirement under this section, for minimum performance length/life of the Internally Illuminated RPM. We should input a minimum requirement which should accommodate the length of the warranty requirement for the project, due to the delicate nature of the electronics involved. This would reduce cost to the Department on the maintenance side. This could even be an Amendment to section 706 or 970, labeled: In-Service Minimum Performance Requirement.

Response: (12-3-18) There is a performance requirement on the luminance of the Class F RPMs in Sub-article 970-2.3.5. No change made.
