- Should be Indexes 430-010 through 430-012
- Add a space before 430-010
- "When concrete mitered end sections are specified in the Plans, the Contractor may use U-Type concrete endwalls, with prior approval from the Engineer". This sentence doesn't work. A contractor cannot prepare a bid based on what the Engineer may or may not approve in the field. You need to provide an approval regime for when these substitutions are acceptable.
