Good Morning Sir – please see below \ \ \ \ \ \ \ proposed new changes to several sections most notably section 5230200 per Rebecca Frimmel FDOT Specifications Coordinator. You can copy that section and then pasted it to your URL Browser to see what the proposed changes are to me it is somewhat confusing. Our concern is the statement that a "Minimum of 14 Days" for the Patterned Pavement to be installed. New Change - (523-23.4 Installation Acceptance: For installation on new asphalt roadways, apply patterned pavement a minimum of 14 days after placement of the adjacent pavement). New Asphalt usually has oils that are still coming up on the surface for at least 28-30 days this could be an issue with the Bondline and Most Pavement Markings that are Coatings. As a precaution we recommend 30 days per our literature attached. It appears to me that they are using a Thermo Marking as the benchmark for the pavement marking in this section regarding the 14 day minimum.
