Comments: (1-18-22, Industry)

My comment on this is that if the 110% is to be applied, it should be for structural courses total thickness only. Friction courses should remain at 105% in order to hold the Contractor accountable for performance. Performance of open graded friction courses is dependent upon maintaining close tolerance to the ¾ inch thickness, and closed graded friction courses contain polymer which results in a higher bid cost for these layers. Any deviations in the base course should be made up by the time the final structural course layer is placed, and this should not be an issue for good contractors.
