Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement- John G./FACERS

 There was also discussion about an update to the traffic signal maintenance agreement. We need to know the plan and status of this. FACERS has been a major participant in the past negotiations about this agreement, and we want to continue that relationship with FDOT.

FDOT Response: The status of this item has not changed since the June 30, 2022 FACERS meeting presentation. FDOT will provide an update and/or coordinate with Traffic Ops to attend and address this item at the Fall FACERS meeting October 6, 2022 if more information is available.

The additional funding for traffic signal maintenance that Trey Tillander requested at the FDOT Performance Planning Workshop is looking good. However, we do not have an approved draft of the TSMCA ready yet for FACERS review. Traffic Ops. will set up a separate meeting with FACERS later this year once we've gotten through our internal reviews and approvals.

Bundling Initiative- John G./FACERS

 Update on status/plans for bundling projects for pavement marking. I understand from our discussion at FACERS meeting that there is a plan for districtwide pushbutton contracts that would provide for counties to also participate. We need an update on the progress of this initiative.

FDOT Response: The status of this item has not changed since the June 30, 2022 FACERS meeting presentation. FDOT staff is presenting on the topic again at the August 2022 Performance Planning Workshop. Brenda and the Safety Office finished compiling the needed local road data on rumble strips and will present this information at today's meeting.
