Internet Subscriber Account

- 1. ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS:** Welcome to the Florida Department of Transportation's Internet Subscriber Account System. This service is provided to you, subject to the following Terms of Use ("TOU"). In addition, when using the Service, you shall be subject to any posted guidelines or rules applicable to such services. All such guidelines or rules are hereby incorporated by reference into this TOU.
- 2. YOUR ACCOUNT:** In consideration of your use of the Service, you agree to: (i) provide true, accurate, current and complete information about yourself as prompted by the Service's registration form and (ii) maintain and promptly update the Registration Data to keep it true, accurate, current and complete. If you provide any information that is untrue, inaccurate, not current or incomplete or the Department has reasonable grounds to suspect that such information is untrue, inaccurate, not current or incomplete, the Department has the right to suspend or terminate your account and refuse any and all current or future use of the Service, or any portion thereof with or without notice. You will receive a password and account designation (the email address you designate) upon completing the Service's registration process. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of the password and account, and are fully responsible for all activities using your account. You agree to (i) immediately notify Customer Support of any unauthorized use of your password or account or any other breach of security, and (ii) ensure that you exit from your account at the end of each session. You are entirely responsible for all content that you upload, post, email, transmit or otherwise make available to the Department through the Service.
