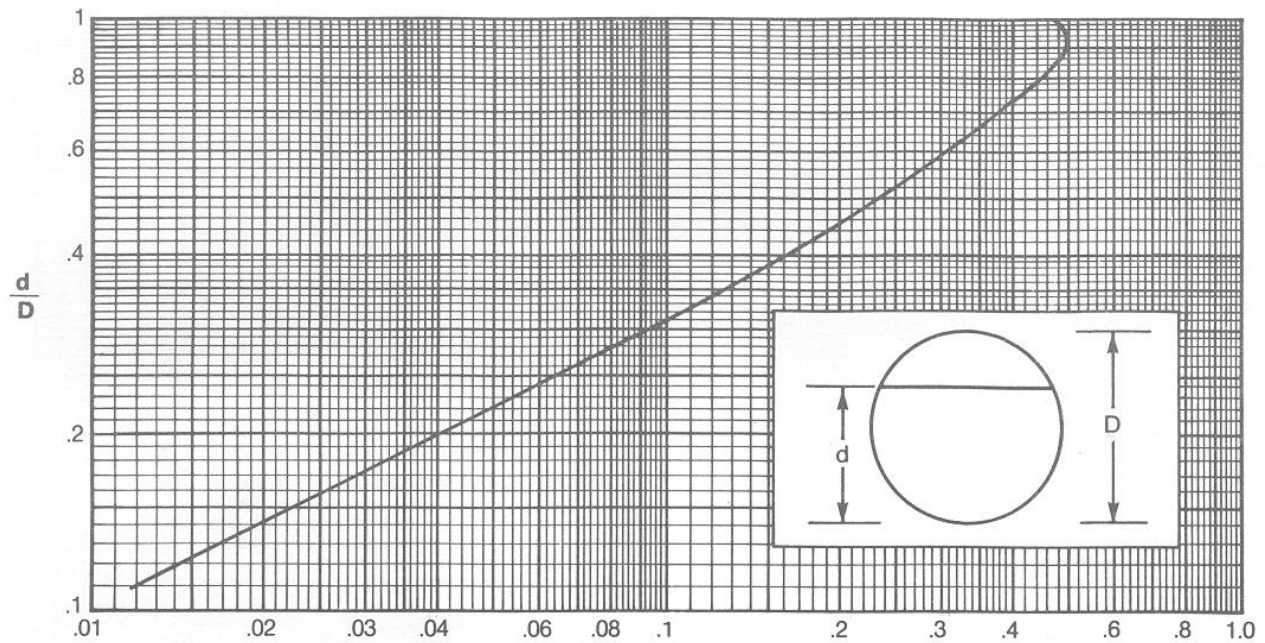

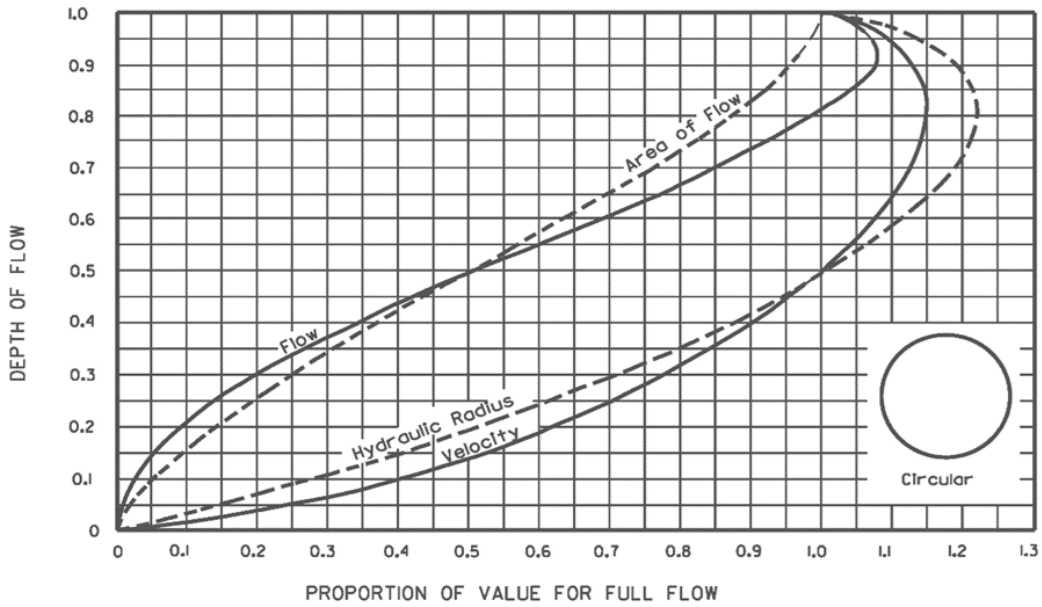

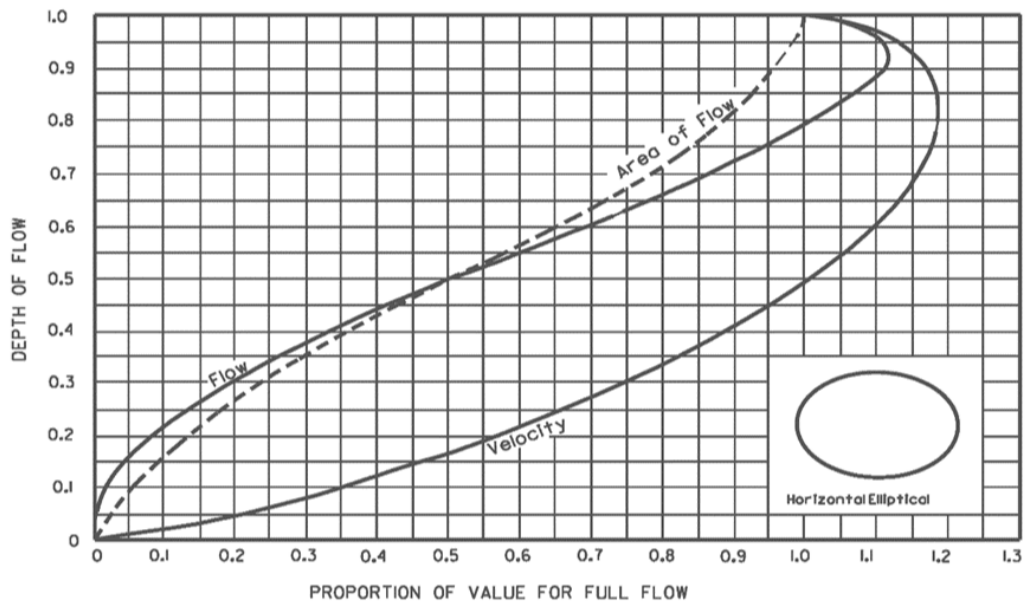

Figure E-1: Circular Pipe Partial Flow Capacity Chart



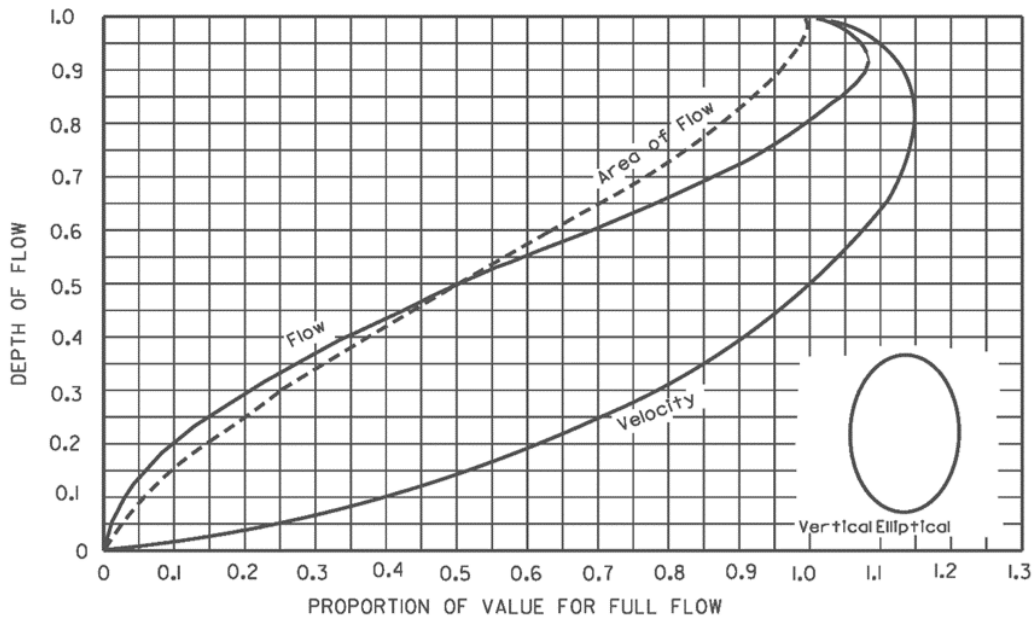

Figure E-2: Circular Pipe Relative Flow, Area, Hydraulic Radius, and Velocity



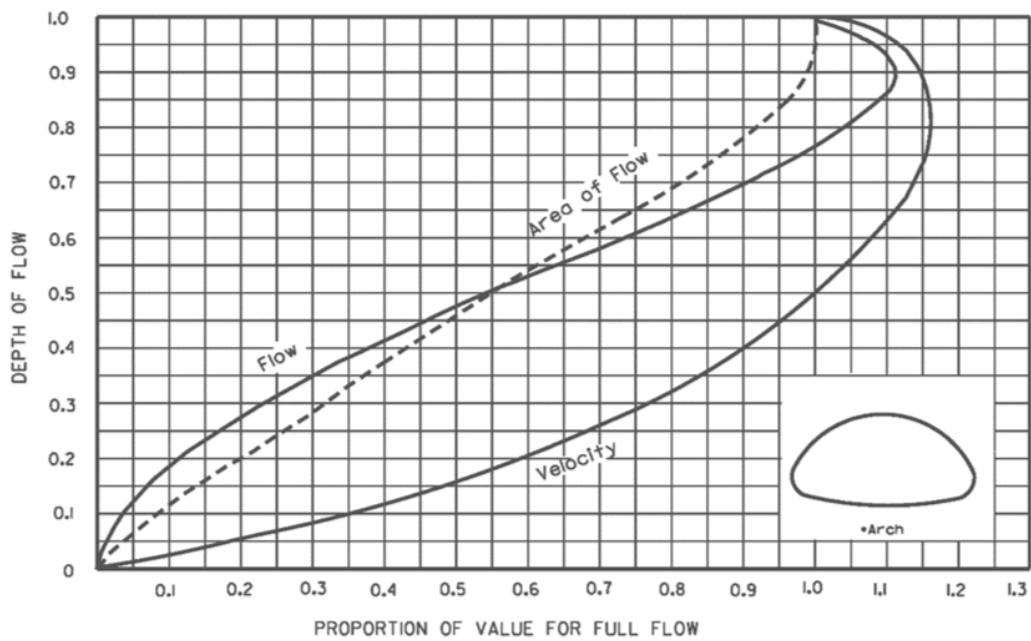
