

BEAUTIFICATION GRANT PROGRAM

The Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT's) Beautification Grant Program aims to enhance the attractiveness of landscapes and facilities on the State Transportation System. Projects are typically installed on FDOT Right-of-Ways but can extend into publicly owned properties that are contiguous and visible from the FDOT Right-of-Way. This is a reimbursement grant, meaning projects must be completed before grantees receive funds.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

This year the maximum grant award is **\$112,000**

Eligible Applicants: Local Governments (Cities, Counties, Municipalities)

Eligible Projects: Purchase and installation of plant materials, soil amendments, and irrigation systems; site preparation.

Applicants should work closely with their District Grant Coordinator throughout the application process. Draft grant application due to District Coordinator by August 14th, 2024, for review.

Grant applications, and letter of authorization from your district grant coordinator must be submitted online by **October 1, 2024**. See the **FDOT Beautification Grant** website for the most up-to-date information.
